| 1 | Aim | I make a judgement about the value, merit, or worth of your intervention. I can help you to improve your intervention. | 7 |

| 3 | Input | I am the ratio of effective outcomes to total inputs. I am the maximum achievement for the least input. | 9 |
| 4 | Output | I am what you want to achieve: what and who you hope to change by the intervention. I have a measurable outcome. | 1 |
| 5 | Outcome | I am routine checks of your intervention's activities. I monitor the progress of your intervention, and alert you if something is not going to plan. I make no judgements. | 6 |
| 6 | Monitoring | I am the changes caused by your intervention. I am linked to objectives, and I can be short-term or long-term. | 5 |
| 7 | Evaluation | I am the actual product of your intervention. I am what you deliver. I am the work done. | 4 |
| 8 | Effectiveness | I am a statement of a specific outcome that your intervention intends to achieve. I am Specific, Measurable, Agreed, Relevant, and Time-limited. | 2 |
| 9 | Efficiency | I am the resources needed to run your intervention. | 3 |

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
