1	Aim	I make a judgement about the value, merit, or worth of your intervention. I can help you to improve your intervention.	
2	Objective	I am how well your intervention achieved its aims and objectives. I am the extent to which your intervention produced the change you expected.	
3	Input	I am the ratio of effective outcomes to total inputs. I am the maximum achievement for the least input.	
4	Output	I am what you want to achieve: what and who you hope to change by the intervention. I have a measurable outcome.	
5	Outcome	I am routine checks of your intervention's activities. I monitor the progress of your intervention, and alert you if something is not going to plan. I make no judgements.	
6	Monitoring	I am the changes caused by your intervention. I am linked to objectives, and I can be short-term or long-term.	
7	Evaluation	I am the actual product of your intervention. I am what you deliver. I am the work done.	
8	Effectiveness	I am a statement of a specific outcome that your intervention intends to achieve. I am Specific, Measurable, Agreed, Relevant, and Time-limited.	
9	Efficiency	I am the resources needed to run your intervention.
